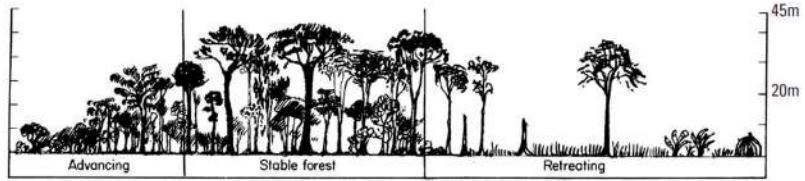


Diagram of forest profile, showing changes in ground cover.

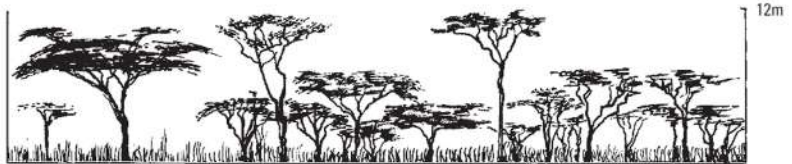

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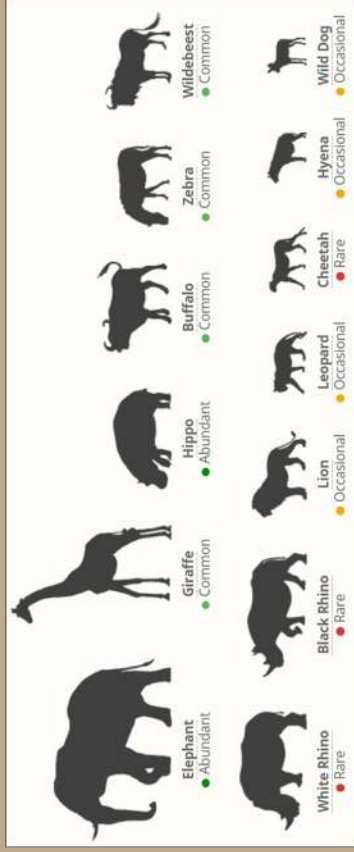
Botswana tiene una población saludable de vida silvestre. La mayoría de los grandes animales de safari se ven fácilmente, con la excepción del rinoceronte, que se ha reintroducido recientemente. Los parques del norte tienen fuentes de agua permanentes y albergan mayores concentraciones de vida silvestre que los parques secos del sur.

BOTSWANA

DELTA DEL OKAVANGO



El delta del Okavango atrae a una gran cantidad de herbívoros en la estación seca, lo que también atrae a los carnívoros. La observación de la vida silvestre es excelente, especialmente en Moremi GR. Cuatro de los Cinco Grandes se ven fácilmente. Se han reintroducido tanto el rinoceronte blanco como el negro, pero los avistamientos siguen siendo raros. Elefantes y búfalos a menudo se ven en tierra y desde el agua.



MOREMI GAME RESERVE



Moremi ofrece una excelente vida salvaje, tanto en tierra como desde un mokoro (canoas). Tanto el rinoceronte blanco como el negro han sido reintroducidos en la reserva. Todos los otros Cinco Grandes son fáciles de detectar. Los avistamientos de leopardos y perros salvajes son algunos de los mejores de África.

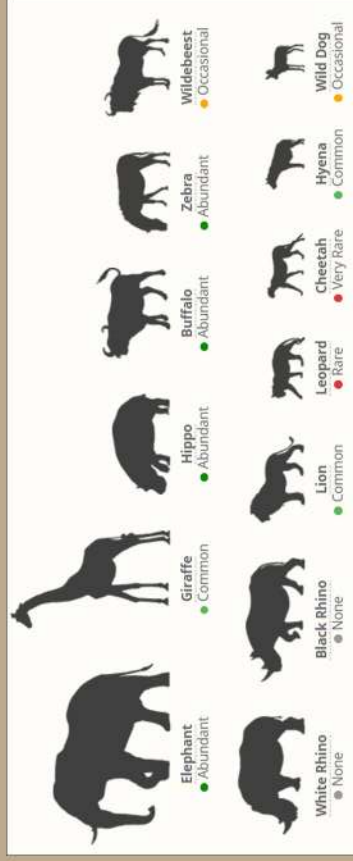

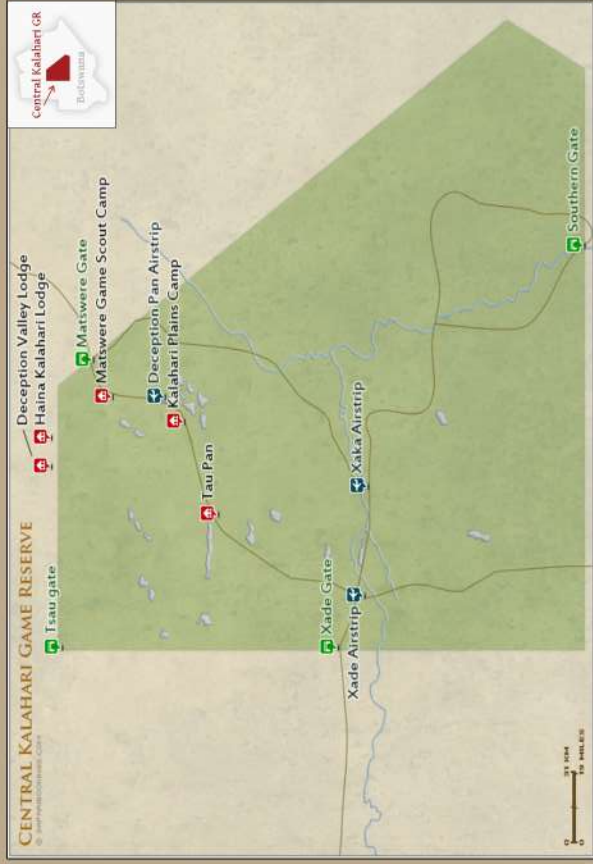
CHOBE NATIONAL PARK



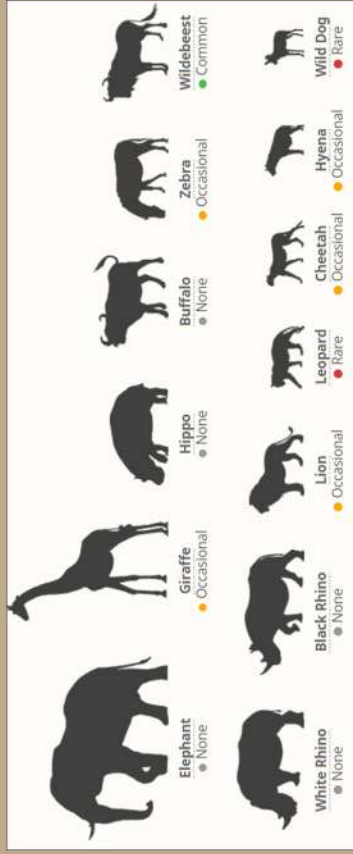
Chobe tiene una impresionante riqueza de vida animal. Los elefantes y búfalos son una presencia permanente en las riberas de los ríos en los meses secos. La cebra de las llanuras, el puku y el impala también son muy comunes, mientras que en el interior del parque se pueden encontrar cantidades más pequeñas de greater kudu y antílope sable. Los leones se ven fácilmente y es posible que tengas suerte si también ves perros salvajes.



CENTRAL KALAHARI GAME RESERVE



Se pueden ver grandes concentraciones de herbívoros, como el ñu azul, el oryx y la gacela, en las charcas llenas de agua en Deception Valley después de las lluvias. Eland, el greater kudu y el red hartebeest se pueden encontrar en cantidades más pequeñas. Cerca están el león y el guepardo Kalahari de melena negra.

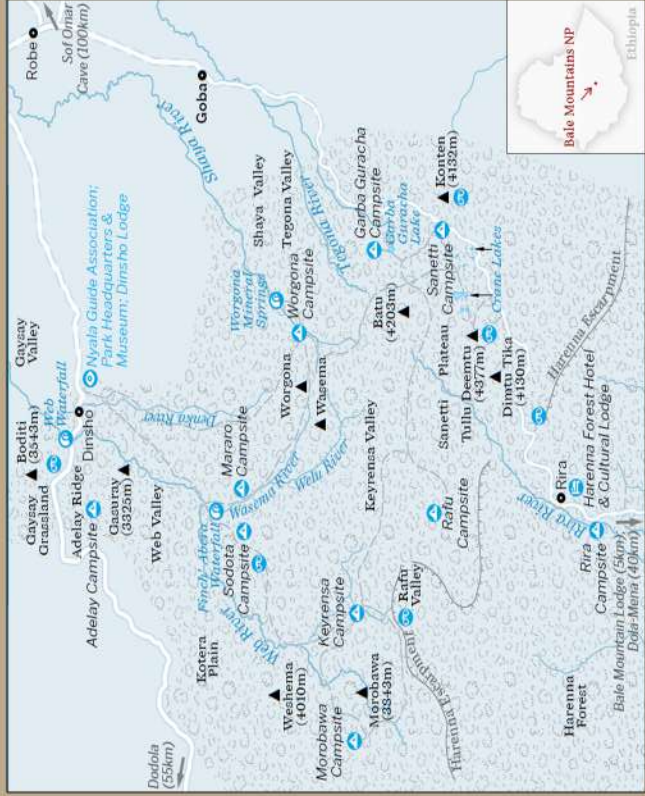

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La vida silvestre de Etiopía es notablemente diversa. Muchos animales de safari convencionales, como elefantes y leones, están presentes en pequeñas cantidades, pero en realidad son las criaturas inusuales de Etiopía las que roban el espectáculo. El lobo etíope, la cabra montés de Walia, el antílope de Swayne y el nyala de montaña son endémicos. Un viaje en barco por el lago Tana es ideal para los hipopótamos, mientras que en el Parque Nacional Nechisar se pueden ver cocodrilos.

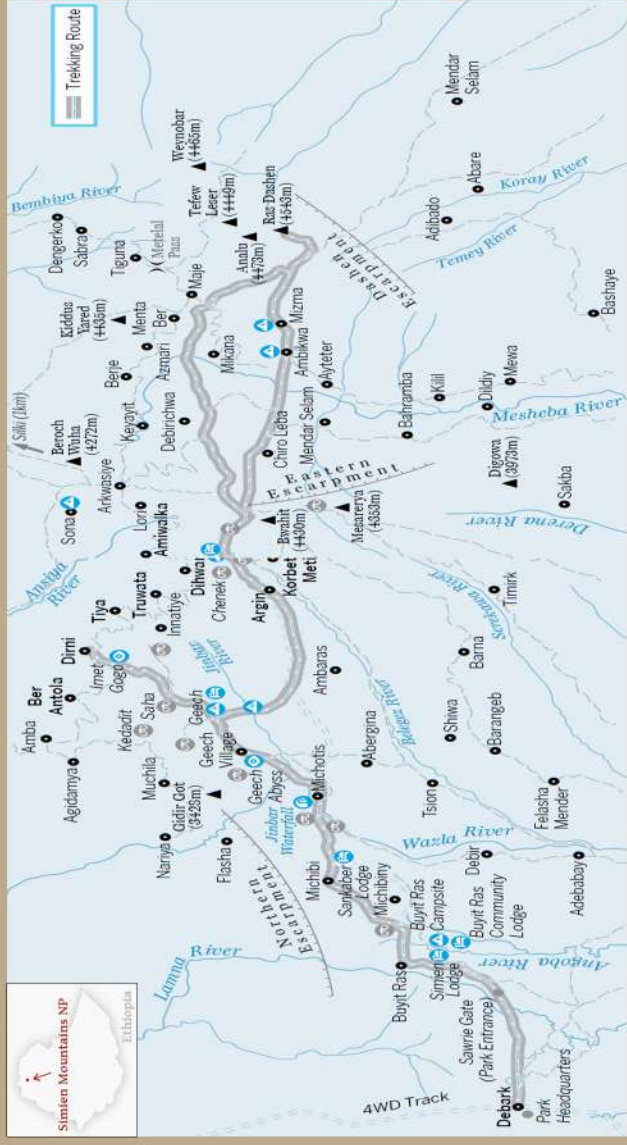
ETIOPIA BALE MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK

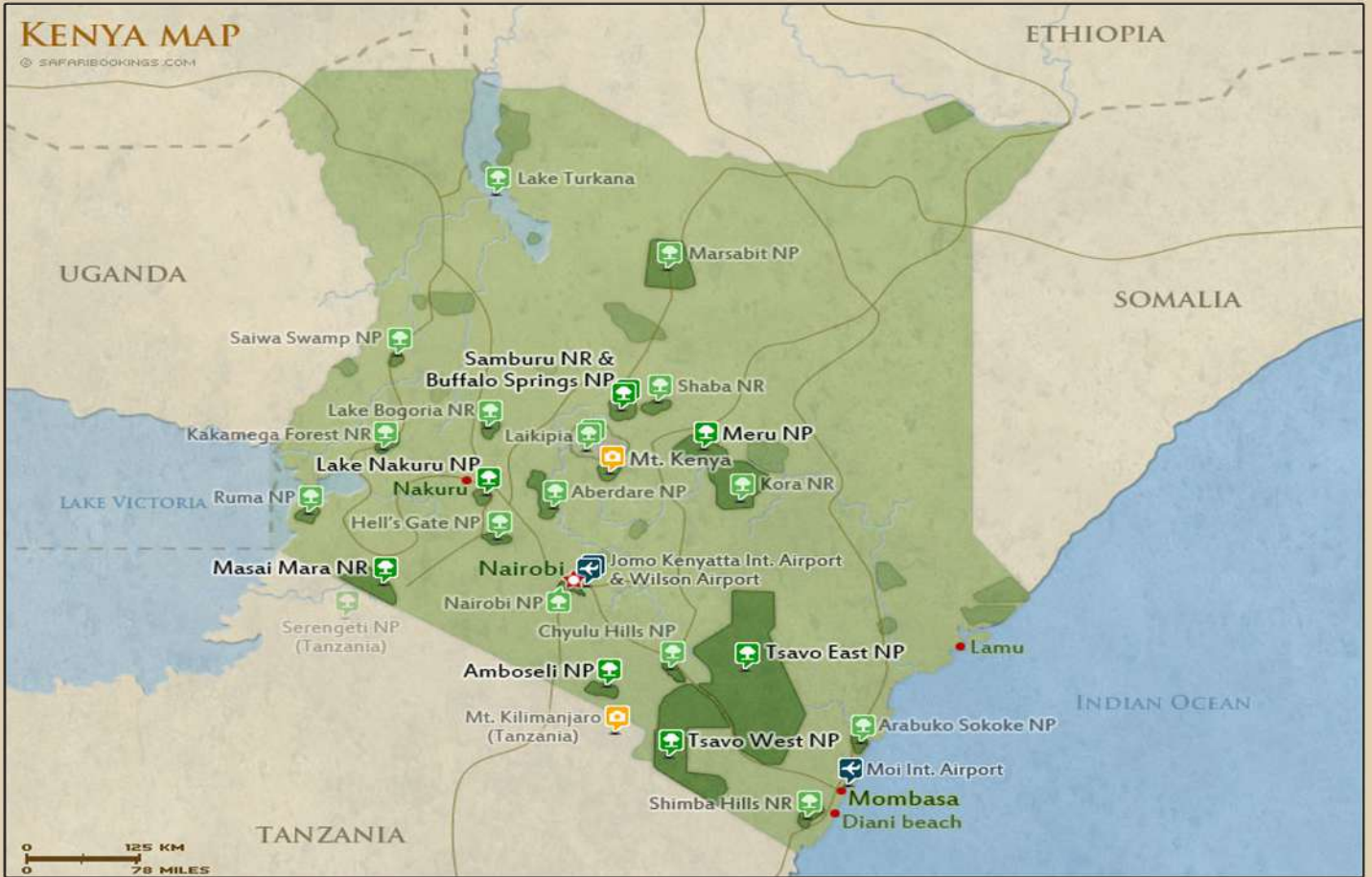
SIMIEN MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK

La Walia ibex otras dos endémicas más buscadas. El golden jackal a veces se encuentra al acecho en los campamentos.

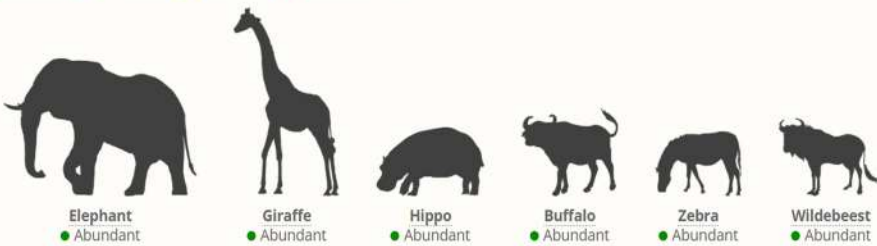

Kenia ofrece una excelente observación de la vida silvestre. Todos los Big Five se ven regularmente en un safari estándar. El Masai Mara es uno de los mejores lugares de África para ver grandes felinos, y el rinoceronte blanco se ve fácilmente en el lago Nakuru. Los lagos del Valle del Rift, especialmente el lago Bogoria, atraen a miles de flamencos, que se alimentan en las aguas poco profundas.

KENIA

MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE



Los avistamientos de cuatro de los Cinco Grandes están prácticamente garantizados. El rinoceronte negro es más escurridizo, pero a veces se lo puede ver en el Triángulo de Mara. La reserva es una de las mejores para los grandes felinos, y de los pequeños como el bat-eared fox, el black-backed jackal y la spotted hyaena. Los antílopes incluyen impalas, reedbucks, gacelas Thomson, antílopes y topi, mientras que búfalos, elefantes y jirafas están relajados y son fáciles de detectar.



AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK



El parque es famoso por sus elefantes, pero la mayoría de los grandes animales de safari se pueden ver aquí. El rinoceronte negro se ha extinguido, pero los otros cuatro de los Cinco Grandes están presentes. Las llanuras albergan una gran cantidad de grandes herbívoros, incluidos los ñus, la cebra de Burchell y las gacelas de Grant y Thomson.



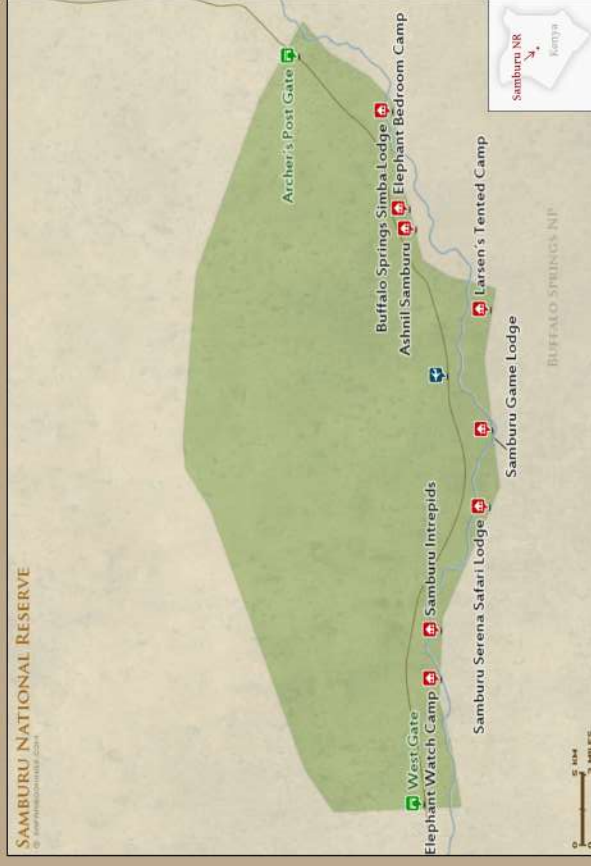
KENIA LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK



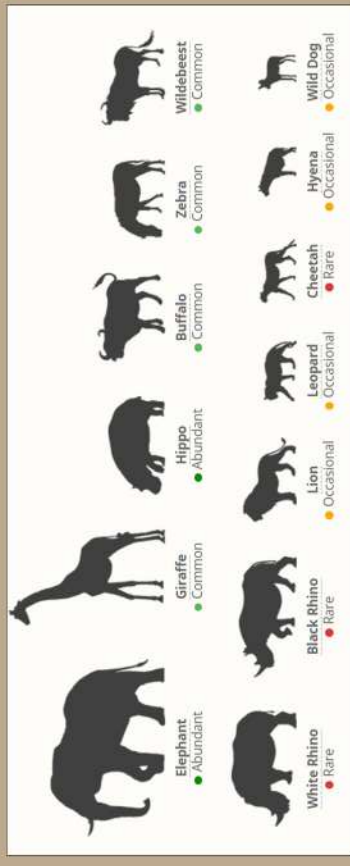
La mayoría de los grandes animales de safari están presentes en el PN del lago Nakuru, con la excepción de los elefantes. El parque es conocido por sus poblaciones de rinocerontes blancos y negros. El rinoceronte blanco es particularmente llamativo y se pueden encontrar diferentes grupos a lo largo del día. El hipopótamo, el antílope, la cebra de Burchell y la gacela de Thomson son comunes en las llanuras aluviales.



SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE



La mayoría de los animales de safari se pueden ver en un par de días. Hay varios leopardos y los avistamientos no son inusuales. Los elefantes abundan y hay una gran variedad de antílopes, incluidos los greater y lesser kudus, con sus impresionantes cuernos. Solo el rinoceronte está ausente de los Cinco Grandes.

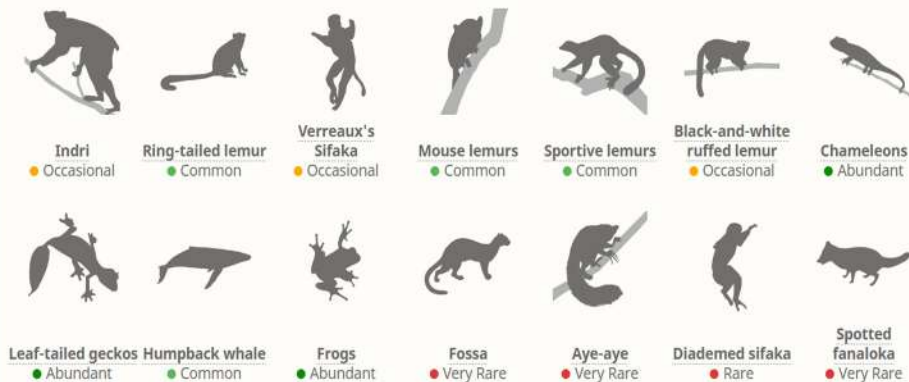

Madagascar tiene una gran variedad de animales, la mayoría de ellos endémicos de la isla, aunque no es un destino típico de vida silvestre. Lémures, camaleones, geckos y ranas se ven fácilmente en todo el país, pero diferentes parques albergan diferentes especies. La isla también es una buena base para observar la fauna marina, en particular la migración estacional de miles de ballenas jorobadas.

ANDASIBE-MANTADIA NATIONAL PARK



La mayoría de la gente solo visita la parte Andasibe del parque, que alberga 11 especies de lémures, incluido el indri, el lémur vivo más grande. Para ver al carismático black&white ruffed lemur, debes viajar a la sección Mantadia del parque.

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Aunque Malawi no es un destino principal de vida silvestre, la conservación está mejorando y el número de vida silvestre está aumentando. El rinoceronte se extinguió en el país, pero se ha reintroducido en Liwonde y Majete, lo que convierte a Malawi en un destino de los Cinco Grandes. Nyika tiene una alta concentración de leopardos, pero en general los grandes felinos no son tan fáciles de ver. Los elefantes son comunes en todas partes y las jirafas se introdujeron recientemente en Majete.

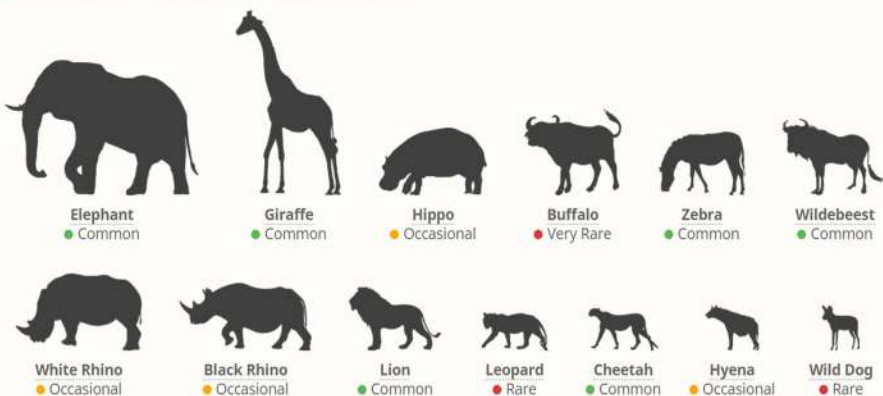

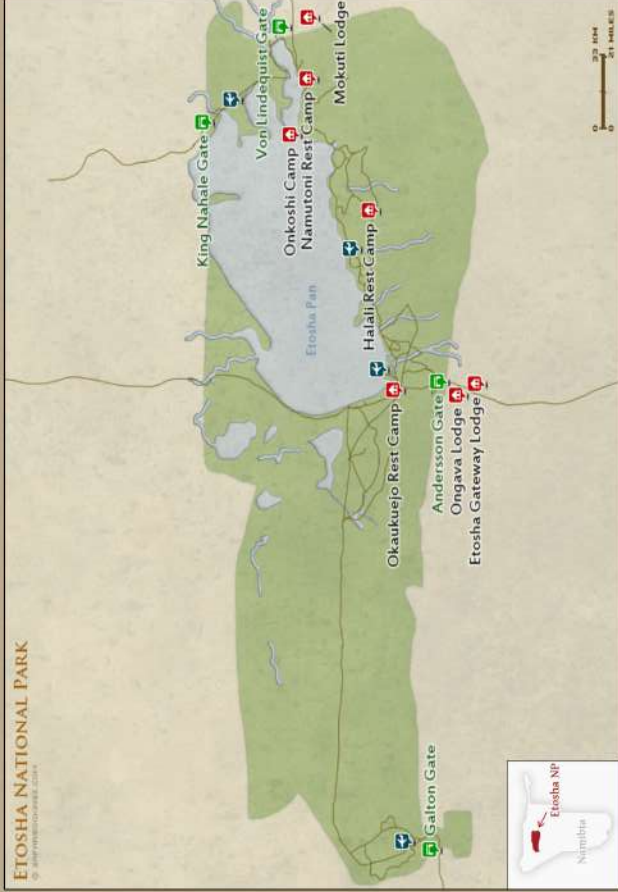


Debido al ambiente árido, el número de animales salvajes es relativamente bajo en Namibia, pero los animales son fáciles de detectar. Todos los grandes depredadores están presentes, y el guepardo es especialmente común en todas partes. Se pueden ver enormes manadas de animales, elefantes en particular, en la estación seca en Etosha pan. Otra fauna marina incluye el raro delfín de Heaviside y la migración de la ballena franca austral.

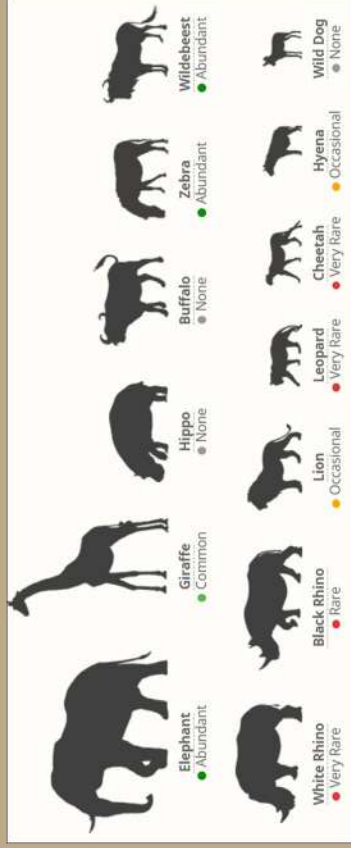

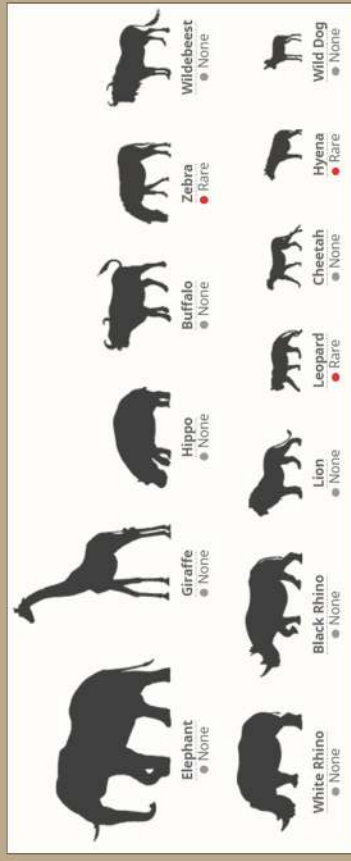
NAMIB-NAUKLUFT NATIONAL PARK



Destaca la variedad y cantidad de animales. Cuatro de los Cinco Grandes están presentes en buen número, solo el búfalo está ausente. Un flujo constante de herbívoros se ve comúnmente en los pozos de agua. Incluyen elefantes, ñus azules, cebras, jirafas y varios antílopes adaptados al desierto, como la gacela y el gemsbok.



Los visitantes vienen aquí para ver el ambiente del desierto. Oryx y springbok son los más llamativos; estos antílopes adaptados al desierto incluso habitan en las áreas más secas del parque. Más cerca de los ríos puedes encontrar klipspringer, steenbok y mandriles adaptados al desierto.

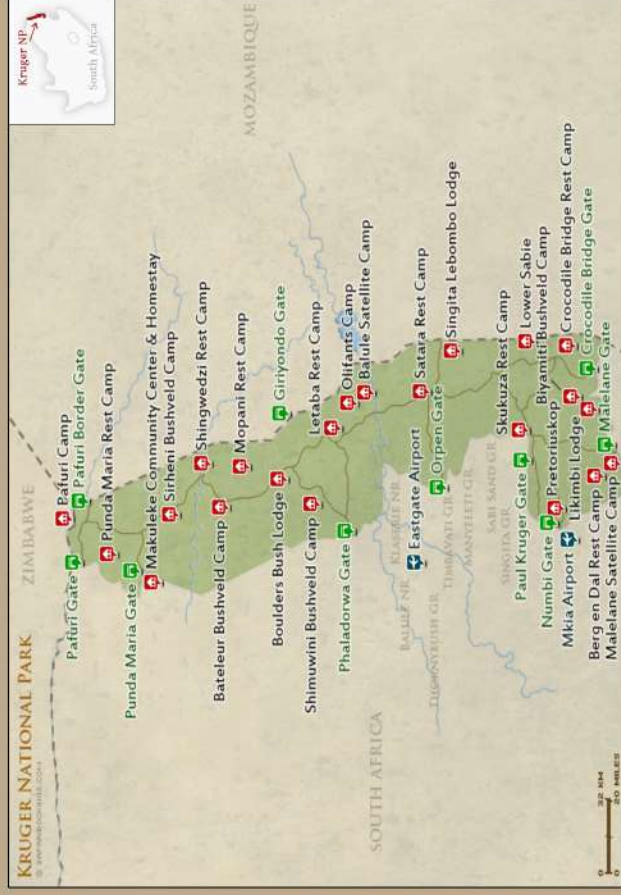
Sudáfrica es un destino privilegiado para la vida salvaje. Todos los principales animales de safari se ven fácilmente. El Parque Nacional Kruger ofrece una excelente observación de la vida silvestre en general, y los pintorescos parques de KwaZulu-Natal son los mejores para ver rinocerontes. En Sabi Sand, el enfoque principal es ver los Cinco Grandes y es famoso por sus leopardos. En la costa podemos ver ballenas francau australes, y tiburones blancos.

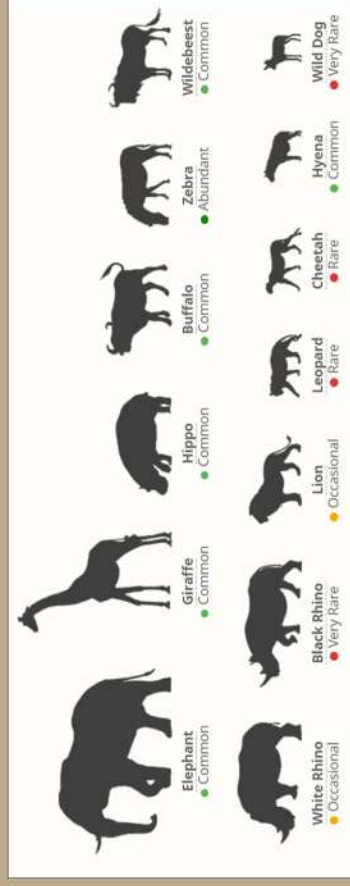

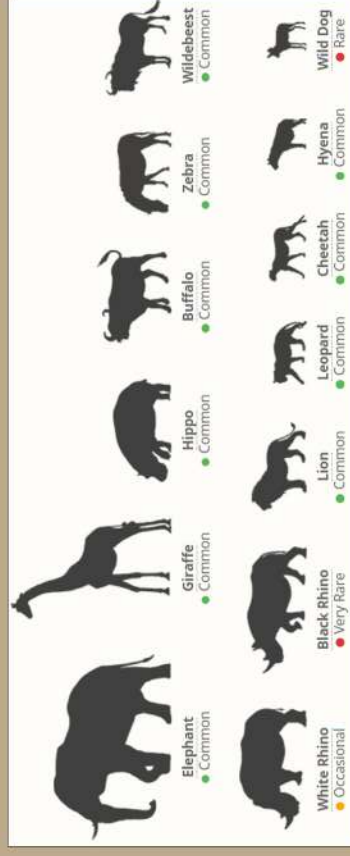

Todos los grandes felinos, y el león, en particular, se ven con frecuencia en el sur del parque. El rinoceronte blanco está amenazado por un aumento dramático de la caza furtiva en los últimos años, pero aún hay una posibilidad razonable de detectar uno. Búfalos y elefantes se ven fácilmente en todas partes.



Todos los Cinco Grandes generalmente se ven en una visita de dos o tres días. La conducción todoterreno asegura avistamientos de calidad, particularmente de los depredadores residentes habituados. Es posible-mente el mejor lugar de África para ver leopardos. Los avistamientos de perros salvajes son menos comunes.

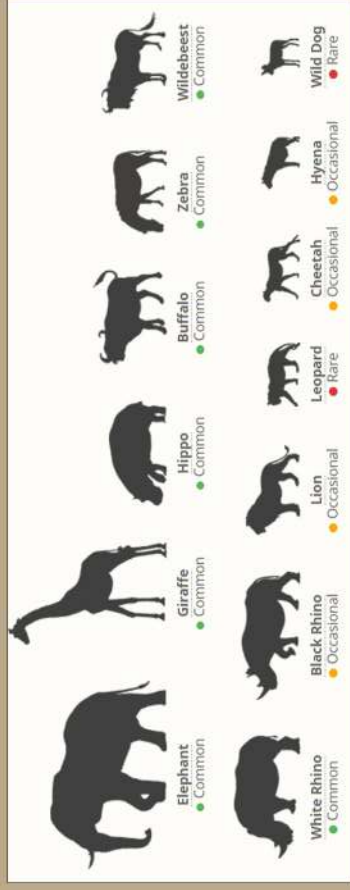

Los tres grandes felinos se ven fácilmente. Los guepardos en las llanuras del sureste, y el leopardo en los grandes árboles a lo largo del río Seronera.



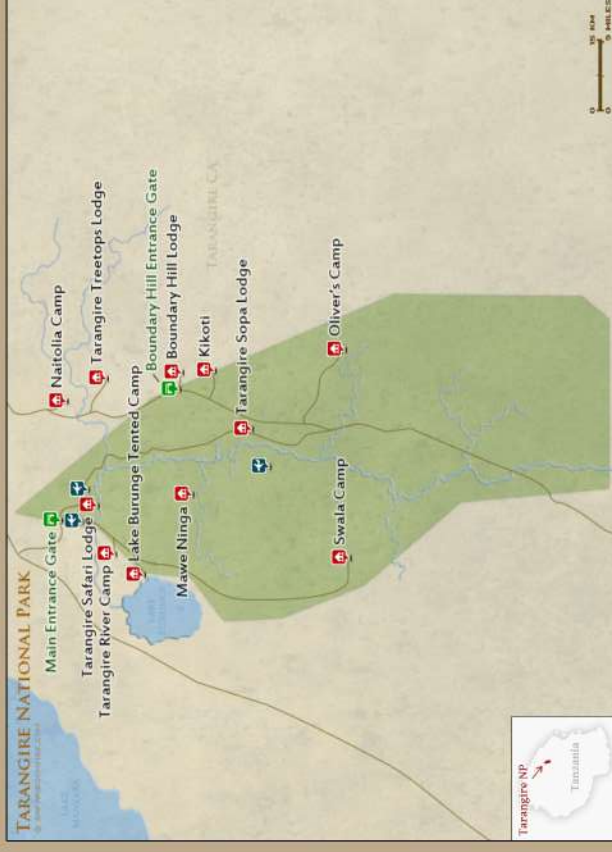

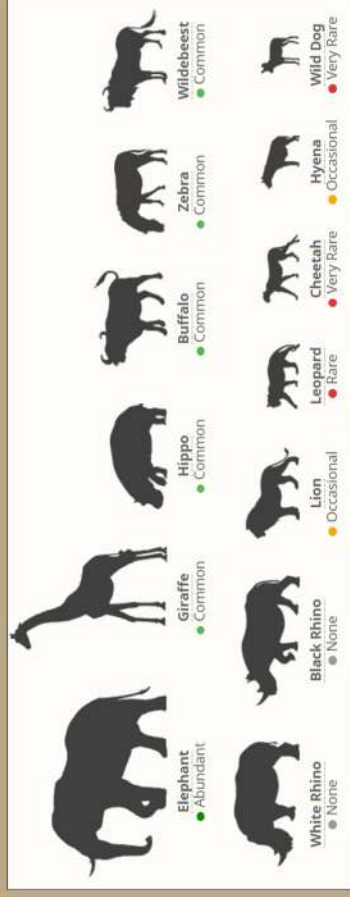

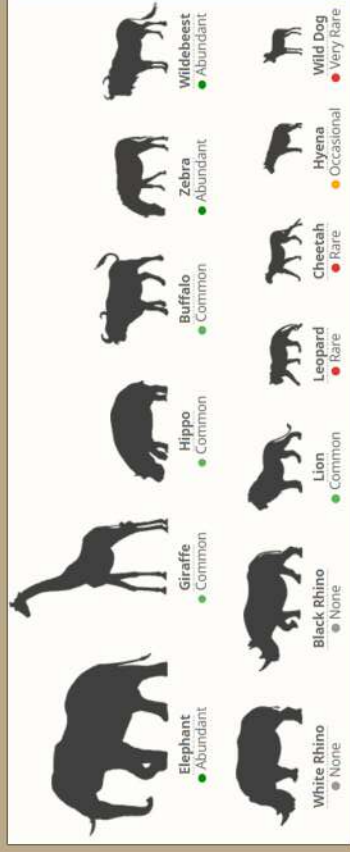

El parque es conocido por sus leones trepadores de árboles y sus impresionantes tusked elephants. Grandes manadas de búfalos, ñus y cebras se congregan en las llanuras cubiertas de hierba. El lago es un hogar estacional para grandes bandadas de flamencos, y se puede encontrar una gran variedad de aves acuáticas en la orilla en todo momento.



En la estación seca, el río Tarangire es un imán para animales migratorios como ñus, cebras, antílopes, antílopes, gacelas, búfalos y elefantes. Los leones también son bastante fáciles de ver. Es el hogar de algunos antílopes de tierras secas, como el raro fringed-eared oryx y el peculiar long-necked gerenuk.

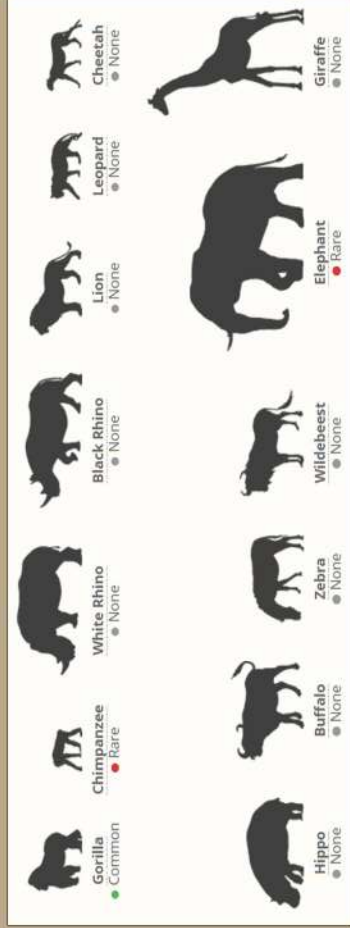
Uganda es un destino único que ofrece una maravillosa mezcla de sabana y parques forestales. El trekking de gorilas y chimpancés es lo más destacado, pero también se pueden ver muchos primates más pequeños. Uganda también ofrece fantásticos safaris por la sabana, y todos los Cinco Grandes están presentes. El león es bastante común en los parques nacionales Queen Elizabeth, Murchison Falls y Kidepo, donde a menudo se les puede encontrar cazando kob de Uganda.

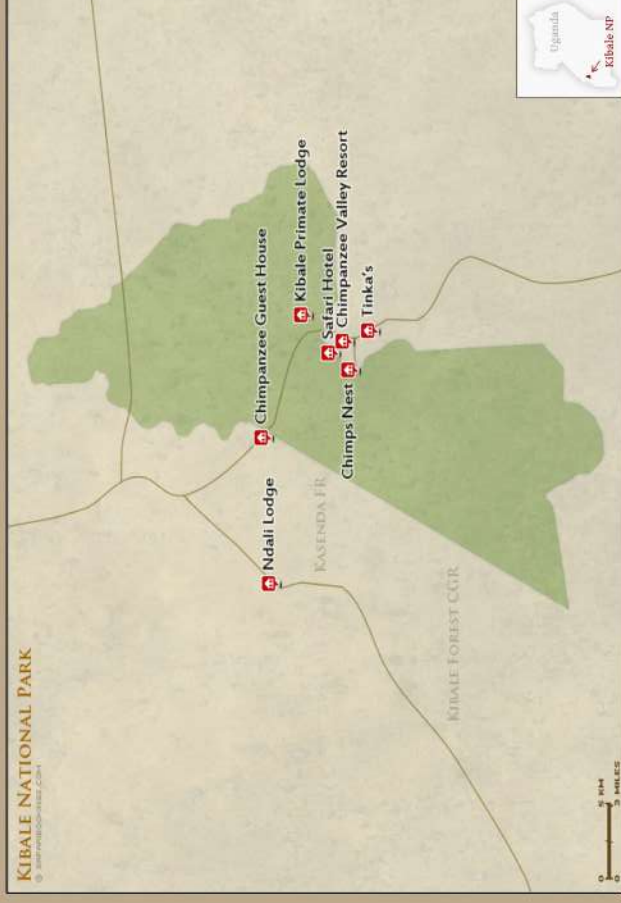

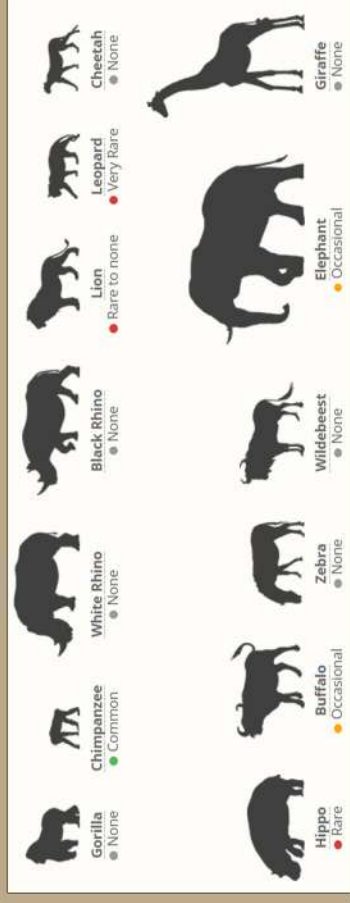

Bwindi tiene más de 120 especies de mamíferos, pero la mayoría son pequeñas criaturas del bosque. El elefante está presente, aunque rara vez se ven. Se encuentran con más frecuencia bushbuck y varios tipos de duiker.

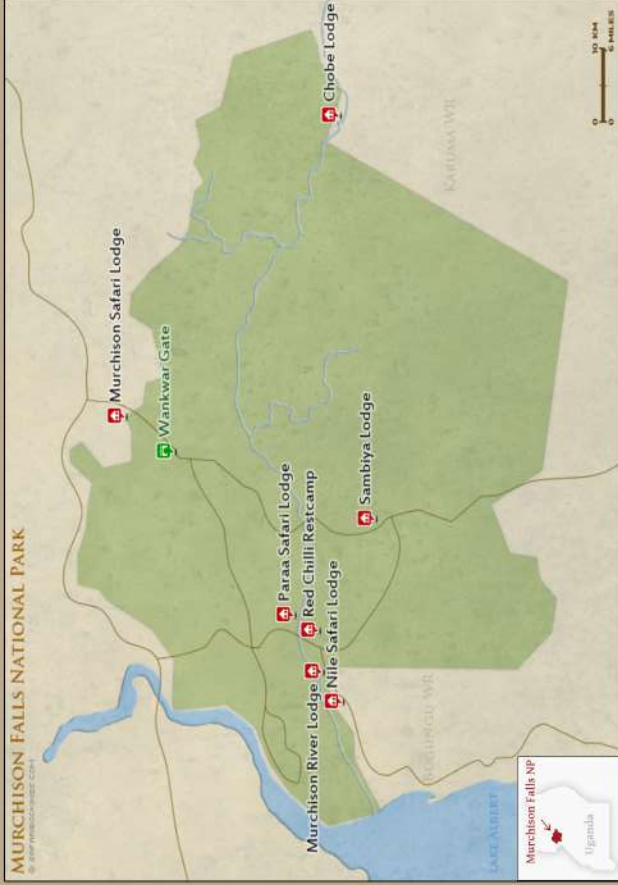

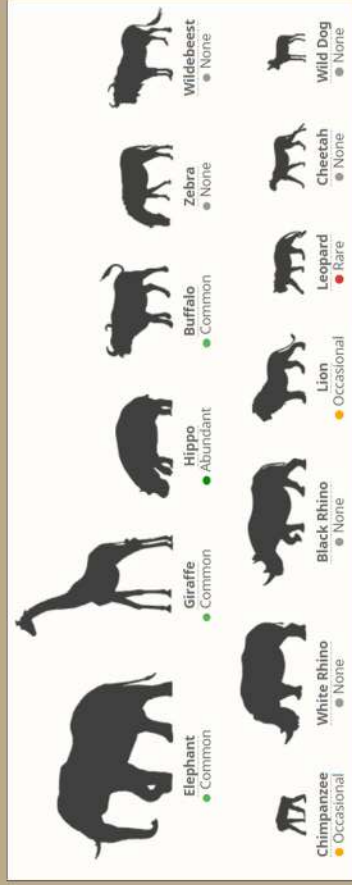

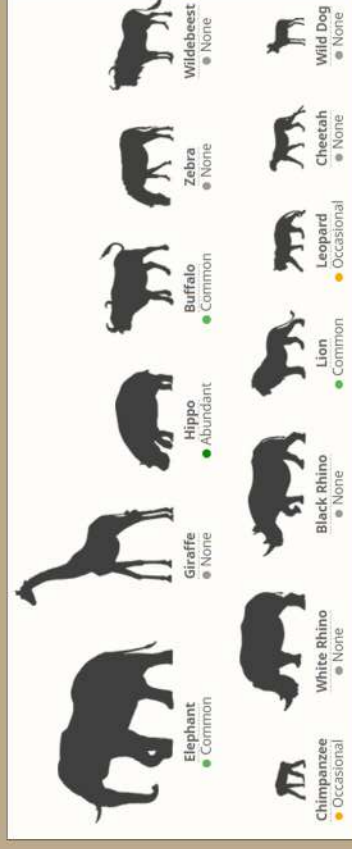
QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK



Se pueden ver cuatro de los Cinco Grandes; sólo los rinocerontes están ausentes. El búfalo y el elefante son comunes. Otros antílopes que se encuentran aquí son el oribi, el Jackson's hartebeest, defassa waterbuck, grey duiker y bushbuck. El Nilo Victoria está repleto de cocodrilos e hipopótamos. Los leopardos se ven en las cercanías de Pakuba Lodge.



Los elefantes y los búfalos son muy comunes, y los leones son fáciles de detectar. Hay muchas especies de antílopes, como el kob de Uganda, el topi y el bushbuck. El hipopótamo y el cocodrilo son comunes en el canal de Kazinga. Los chimpancés se ven fácilmente. La jirafa y la cebra están ausentes.

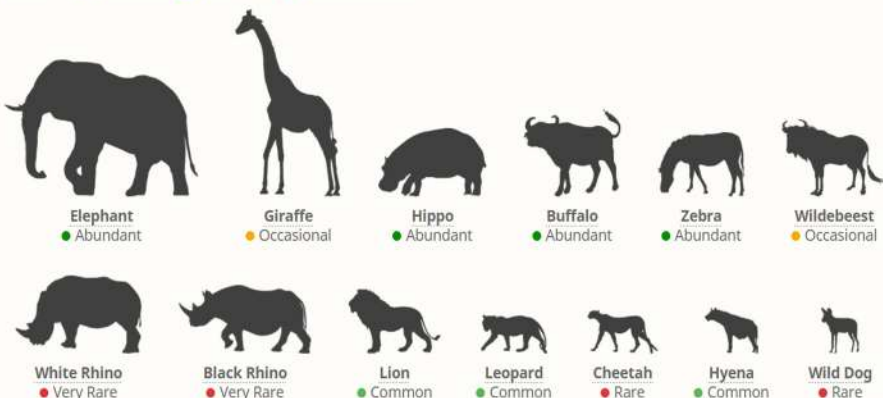

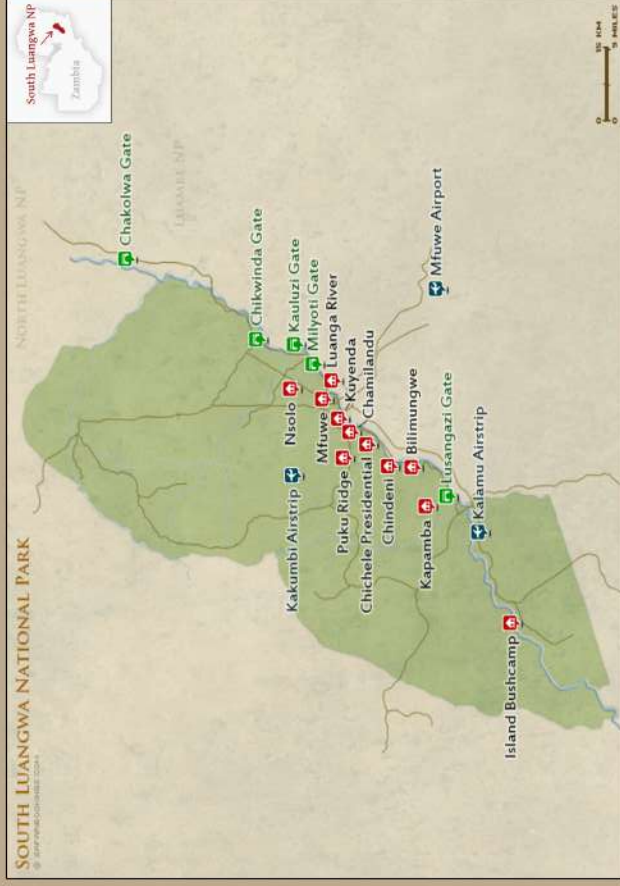

Zambia es un excelente destino de safari, y la mayoría de los animales de alto perfil se ven con relativa facilidad. South Luangwa, Lower Zambezi y Kafue son particularmente buenos para avistar leopardos, pero los perros salvajes y los guepardos son más difíciles de detectar. El rinoceronte negro solo está presente en North Luangwa y el rinoceronte blanco solo en Mosi-oa-Tunya.

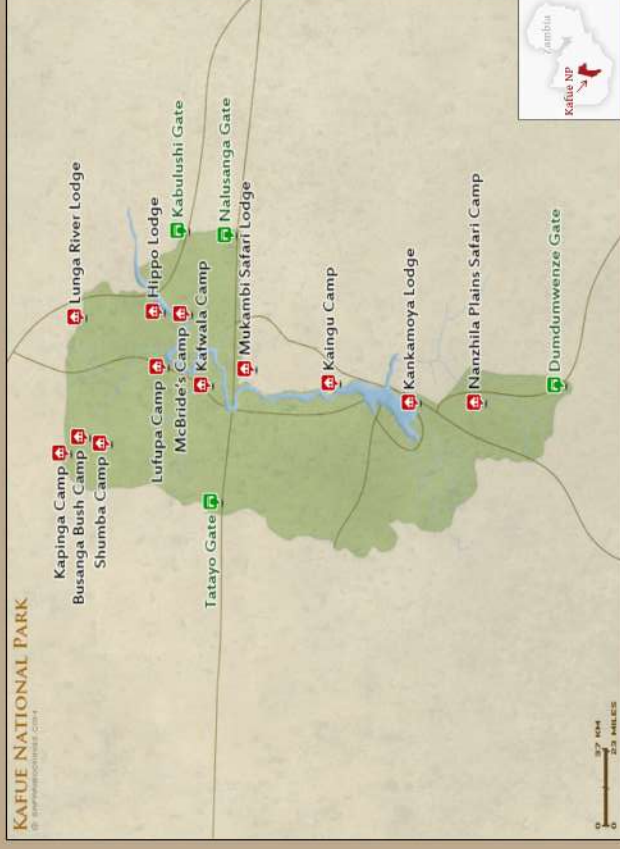
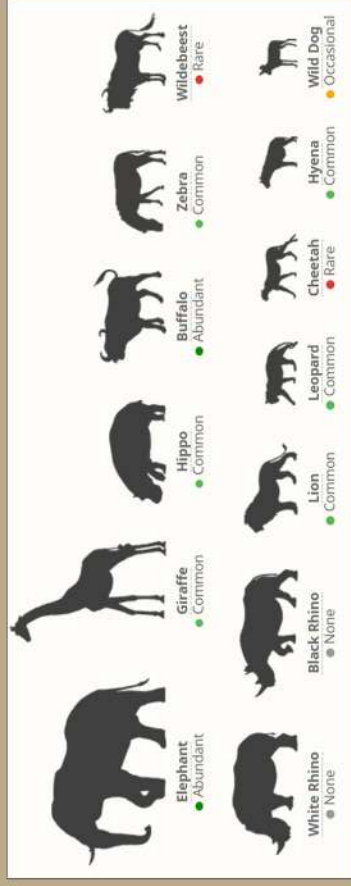

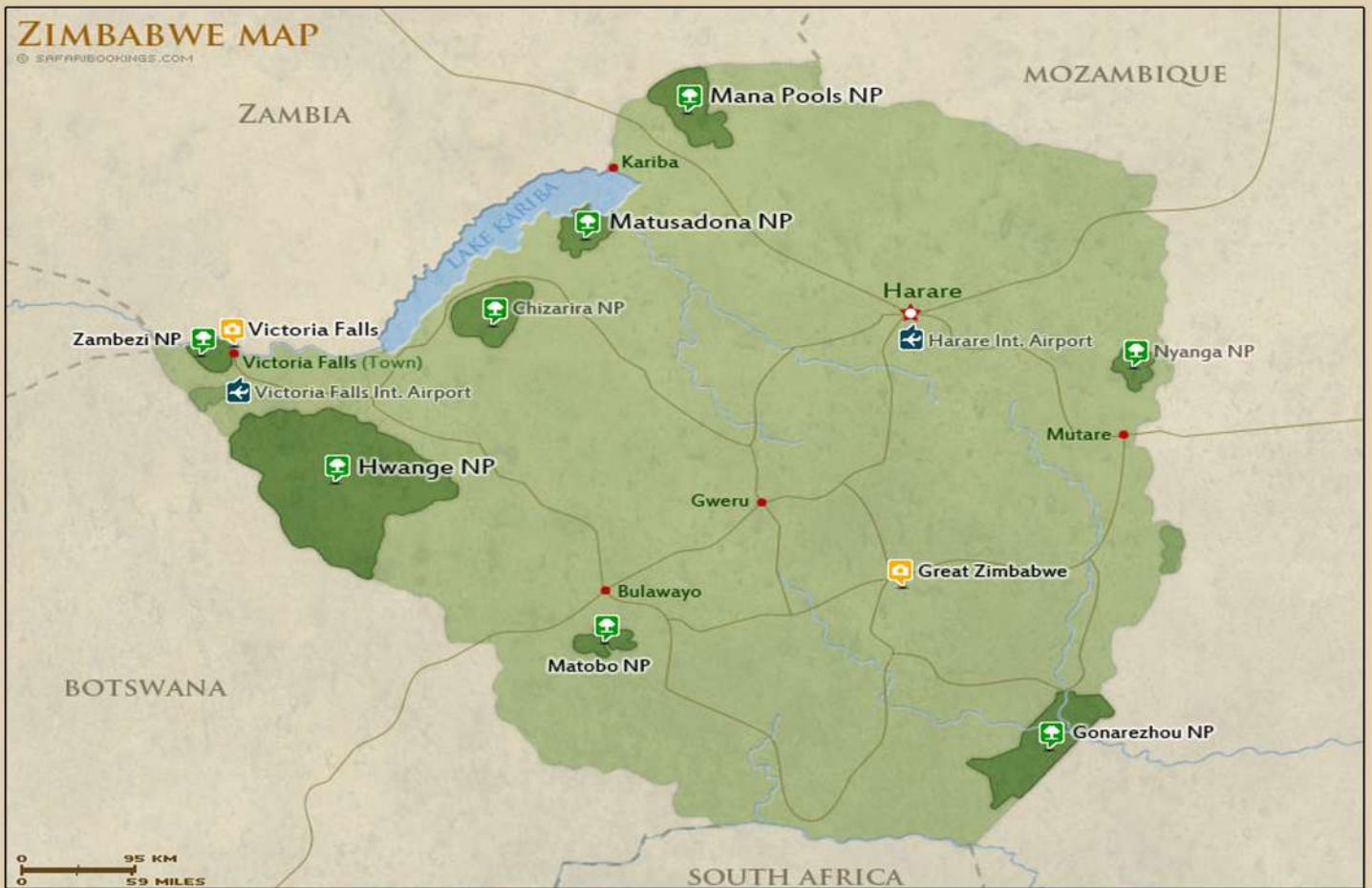

Hay un gran número de búfalos, elefantes, hipopótamos y cocodrilos. Los grandes felinos también, incluidos el guepardo y el leopardo. Destacan las enormes manadas de antílopes, especialmente el red lechwe y el puku en los humedales. En terrenos más secos, Lichtenstein's hartebeest, roan antelope y oribi.

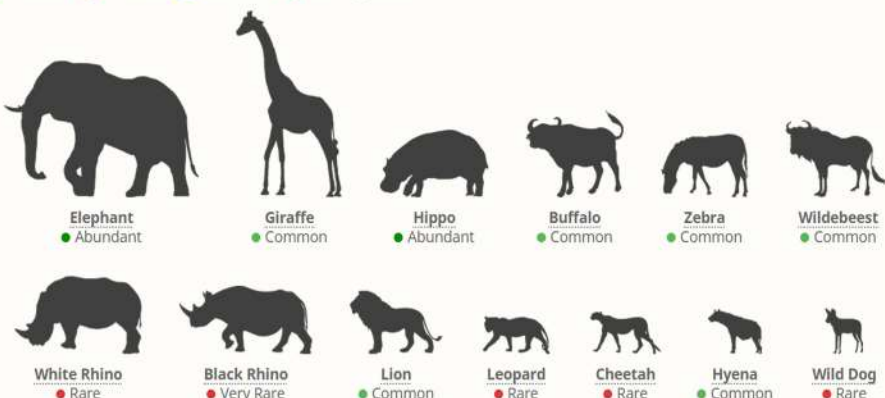

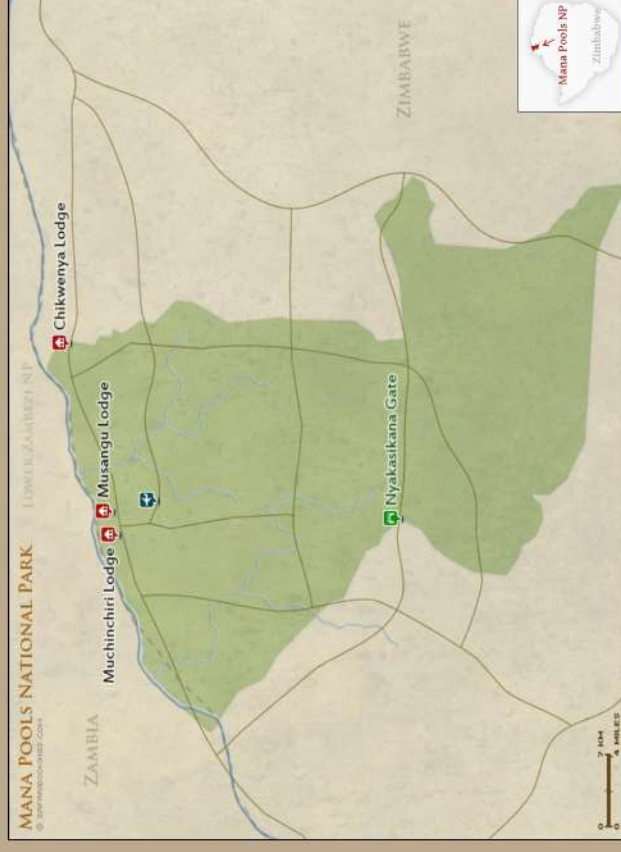

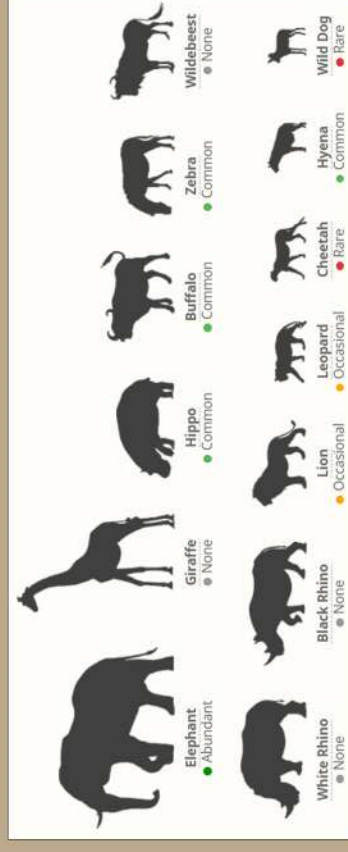


El hermoso antílope sable es un especial de Hwange, así como la hiena parda, el zorro orejudo y la liebre primaveral, que habitan en las arenas de Kalahari de la región. Zimbabwe es un buen destino para ver al perro salvaje en peligro de extinción, y el tejón de miel nocturno se ha habituado bastante a algunos de los parques y, a veces, se puede ver alrededor de los campamentos y sitios para acampar por la noche.

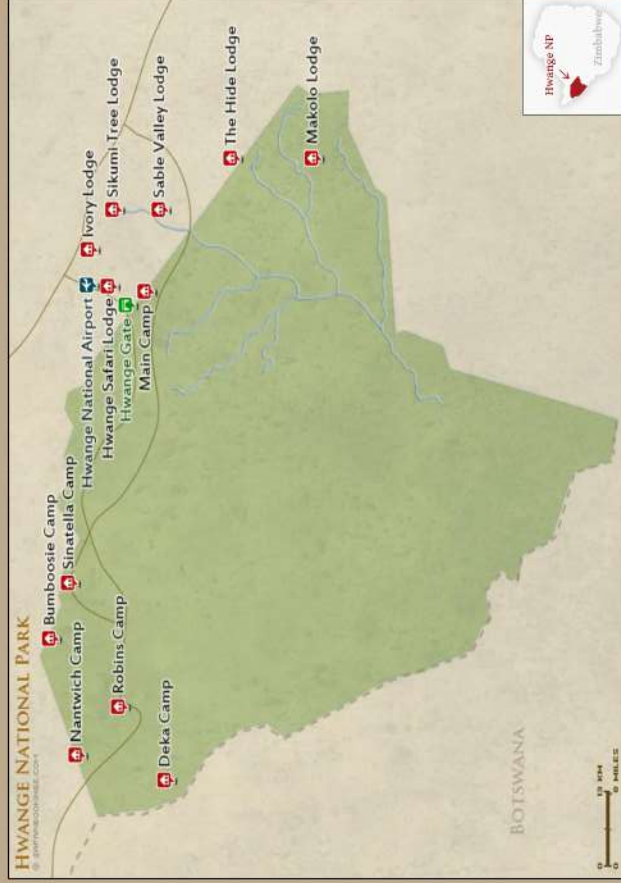
MANA POOLS NATIONAL PARK



Se pueden ver cuatro de los Cinco Grandes. Los búfalos son abundantes y hay una gran concentración de leones y leopardos en el sur del parque. El parque es más conocido por sus elefantes. Tiene una densidad muy alta de perros salvajes.



HWANGE NATIONAL PARK



La población de elefantes en Hwange es una de las más grandes del mundo. Las grandes manadas que se congregan alrededor de los pozos de agua al final de la estación seca son un espectáculo digno de contemplar. Todos los Cinco Grandes están presentes y son fáciles de detectar, con la excepción del rinoceronte blanco y negro.
